## LITTLE BROMLEY PARISH COUNCIL ELECTION OF PARISH COUNCILLORS

1. Nomination papers may be obtained from the Clerk to the relevant Parish Council or the offices of the Returning Officer at the Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE during office opening hours (8.45 a.m. to 5.15 p.m. Mondays to Thursdays and 8.45 a.m. to 4.45 p.m. on Fridays), who will, at the request of any local government elector for the said parish/parish ward, prepare a nomination paper for signature.
2. Completed nomination papers must be delivered by hand to the Returning Officer at the Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE during office opening hours (8.45 a.m. to 5.15 p.m. Mondays to Thursdays and 8.45 a.m. to 4.45 p.m. on Fridays), from the date of this notice but not later than 4.00 p.m. on Wednesday 3 April 2019.
3. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday 2 May 2019, between the hours of 7.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m.
4. The last day to submit an application to be included in the electoral register to be used at this election is Friday 12 April 2019.
5. Applications for, amendments to or cancellations of arrangements to vote by post or by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE by 5.00 p.m. on Monday 15 April 2019, if they are to be effective for this election.
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE by 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday 24 April 2019.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election applied for on grounds of a medical emergency or because of work/service reasons, either of which must have occurred after 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday, 24 April 2019, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Station Road, Clacton-on-Sea, Essex, CO15 1SE by 5.00 p.m. on Thursday 2 May 2019.
